Grooming Hours:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

Check In = 8:30 - 9:30am

Check Out time is set by groomer at check in, but is never later than 1 hour prior to hospital closing time.

Closed on major U.S. holidays.

Essential Grooming Package (base)

- Initial clipper trim, bath, blow dry, basic brushing & dematting, final scissor trim by hand. Time intensive brushing or dematting may incur an additional charge.
- Nails trimmed if necessary/desired (when possible, based on your pet's temperament).
- Basic ear cleaning (serious problems may require veterinarian exam & medication).
- Prices are based on the species & weight of your pet. Please ask your Groomer or a Receptionist for current pricing.

Express Service (upgrade)

- Yours will be the first groom of the day, so that your pet can return home as early as possible. Please discuss with your Groomer at drop-off as exact pickup times will vary.
- Space is limited per day, 1st come, 1st served. Please ask in advance whenever possible
- Additional charge to any package level.

Mini Groom - Face, Paws, Tail

- Your Groomer will trim the hair around your pet's face, paws, &/or tail.
- Charge varies by breed and work to be performed.
- Ear cleaning and bath are not included, but can be purchased separately.



Baths

- Includes bath with specially formulated pet shampoo, blow dry, nails trimmed if needed (when possible, based on your pet's temperament), and basic ear cleaning.
- Specialty shampoos can be added for skin & allergy conditions or to treat for fleas & ticks.
- Prices are based on the breed & weight of your pet. Please ask your Groomer or Receptionist for current pricing.

ala Carte Services

- Specialty Cuts Poodle? Schnauzer? Yorkie? Custom styles are available for many breeds.
- <u>Sanitation Clip</u> The areas under the tail & between the rear legs are trimmed to help improve potty-time cleanliness.
- <u>Teeth Brushing</u> Can be performed at any time, with or without other grooming services.
- <u>Nail Trims</u> Don't need a bath or groom, but the nails are starting to be a problem? Your Groomer will be happy to remedy that for you.
- <u>Ear Cleaning</u> Included with grooming, shave downs, and baths, but can be done separately as well.
- Anal Glands If your pet needs anal glands expressed between grooms, an appointment can be made with a technician just for that.

 Shampoos, brushes, & cologne are available for sale to help you keep your pet's coat clean & smelling good in between grooming visits.

Please Note...

- Grooming patients must show proof of negative fecal test within the last year, & be up to date for the following vaccines:
 - Bordetella (every 6 months)
 - Rabies (annually)
 - DAP (annually)
 - Lepto 4 strain (annually)
 - Heartworm test (annually)
 - Canine Influenza Bivalent (dogs only, annual)
- We must keep our facility flea/tick and parasite free for the health of all patients. Therefore, ALL pets are *required* to be on a vet approved flea, tick (cats and dogs) and heartworm (dogs) preventative prior to admission. If they are not, we will administer flea, tick and heartworm medication which will be added to your invoice. Please let us know product names and most recent application dates as well as any known allergies at check in.
- Special handling may be charged if a patient is not cooperative.
- Sedation may be required for some "rowdy" patients. Pre-anesthetic tests may be required depending on the patient's age.
- Pick up times vary by day. Please inquire when dropping your pet off. Any patient still here at closing will be charged for boarding until picked up.
- Many medical services can be provided while your pet is here for grooming. Ask for more information when scheduling your groom.
